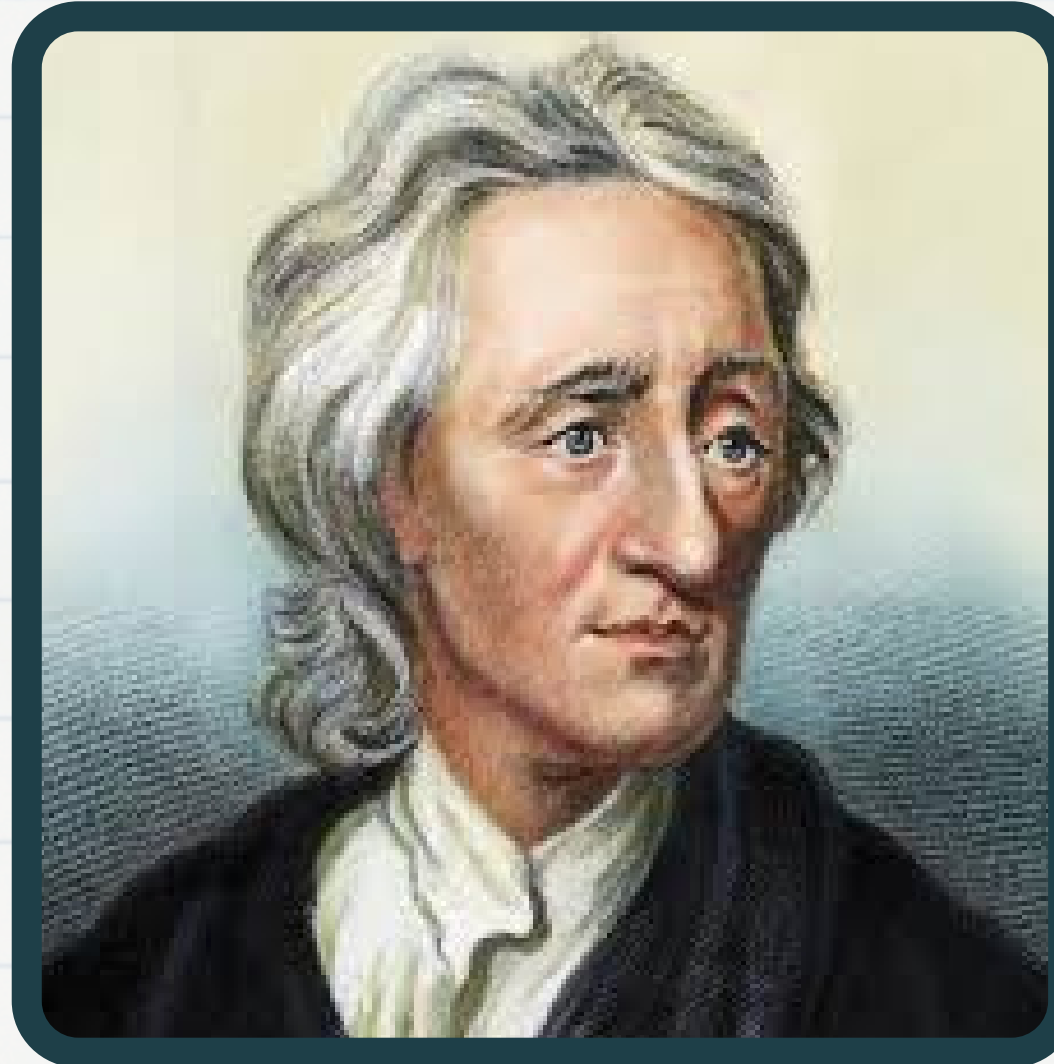


John Locke
