Danielsonville, Conn., April 3.—Henry Hammond, the abolitionist, died here this morning. He was born in Pomfret, Conn., in 1814. He was instrumental in forming the first anti-slavery society in the State, and in 1847 was associated with Hon. Salmon P. Smith of New York and others in forming the memorable Buffalo platform. His residence in Pomfret formed a link in the "underground railway."
